Demands: We want bi+!

Bi+ education!

- Obligatory education about sexual and gender diversity including bi+ realities in educational institutions.
- Develop awareness about bi+ specific challenges in health care systems and society in general.
- Financial support for research studies from and about bi+ people.

ncluding bi+ within LGBTQIA+!

- Specification and recognition of bi+ within the LGBTIQA+ community to achieve more participation.
- Financial support of intersectional projects aiming at empowering minorities.
- Embedment of concepts of inclusivity and diversity at LGBTIQA+ events.

More Political bi+ participation!

- Establishment of a nationwide plan of action aiming at the acceptance of sexual and gender diversity.
- Representation of bi+ interests in committees and networks.
- Openness towards the sexual and gender identity of politicians as role models.

Official acknow edgement of bi+!

- Equal right of asylum for persecuted bi+ people just like for homosexual and trans* people.
- Revision of custody and adoption rights for same-sex couples including bi+ people.
- Abolition of law which prohibits gay and bisexual men as well as trans* people to donate blood.

Inviolability of human dignity also for LGBTQIA+!

- Addition of sexual orientation and gender identity in Article 3 of the German Constitution.
- Involvement of affected representatives for the constitutional change especially with regards to the aspect of intersectionality.
- More support with regards to LGBTQIA+ rights abroad.

ViSibility of bi+ diversity - we are bi+!

- Financial support of visibility campaigns concerning bi+ issues.
- Annual hoisting of the bisexual flag on Bi Visibility Day.
- Support of the annual Bi+Pride campaign in Germany

Standing by our allies!

- Replacement of the Transsexual Act by a law which is accepted by the community.
- Prohibition of unrequired medical surgeries of intersex children.

Understanding bi+

Based on the definitions by the Bisexual Research Center (BRC), BiNe – Bisexuelles Netzwerk e. V. and the US-American bi activist Robyn Ochs, we understand bi+ as a community of people who acknowledge the potential of feeling romantically and/or sexually attracted to people of more than one gender, not necessarily at the same time, in the same way or degree.

We reject the concept of binary genders and use + to explicitly include all people who identify themselves as bi-curious, pansexual, queer, omnisexual, polysexual, homo-/heteroflexible, asexual and other non-monosexual labels or decide against labelling their sexual identity at all.

We attempt to unite the community, which uses different labels or non-labels, to create a united voice within the LGBTQIA+ scene and society.
